

Institutional Strategic/Perspective Plan for 2017-18

1. NBA Accreditation for three Programmes:

IQAC has decided to apply to NBA Accreditation for three UG Programmes: Chemical Engineering, Electrical and Electronics Engineering and Information Science and Engineering. IQAC has taken initiatives to submit its Self Assessment Report (SAR) to NBA and three programmes are accredited for three years (2018-19 to 2020-21) based on the NBA expert team inspection.

2.NAAC Accreditation:

IQAC has decided to apply to NAAC Accreditation IQAC has taken initiatives to submit IIQA form, Self Study Report (SSR) to NAAC. The Institution is accredited with B++ grade (3.00/4) based on the NAAC expert team inspection.

3.Technology in Education:

Technology in education is an initiative started in 2017-2018. The aim of TIE is to motivate faculty members to use the new upcoming technologies in their lectures. This can be in the form of animated power point presentations, animated videos and simulation tools. These tools will assist the faculty members to explain the complicated topics in a clearer and better way. 4. Integrated Innovation Club (I²C):
